<p><b><u>Literacy</u></b></p> <p><b>Text</b> <b>Sentence</b> <b>Word</b> <b>Talking &amp; Listening</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Introduce the language of books - front/back cover, page, picture, word, letter, upper/lower case, sentence. one to correspondence</li> <li>• Conventions of print - Left /right movement, top/bottom, spacing, features in written language i.e. punctuation</li> <li>• Retelling stories in own words</li> <li>• Shared and guided reading - sequencing events in stories, joining in with repetitive lines, make predictions.</li> <li>• Develop active listening skills, Concentration, memory, discrimination, sequencing, and visual discrimination.</li> <li>• Develop auditory/visual memory, and discrimination, syllabification through rhymes and stories.</li> <li>• Nursery rhymes - looking for rhyming words, finding other words that rhyme, clapping a steady beat, matching word to word and sequencing, responding to nursery rhymes (acting, puppets, etc)</li> <li>• Phonics initial sound work</li> <li>• High frequency word introduction</li> <li>• Pre - writing skills, comfortable grip and control, left/right movement using different media to develop skills, sand, paint, white boards, chalk.</li> <li>• Formation of letters in own name</li> <li>• Modelled, shared and guided writing, direction and spacing</li> <li>• Constructing sentences, know that a sentence begins with a capital letter and ends with a full stop and finger spacing between words</li> </ul>
